China is a completely different world than what we can see in local Chinese restaurants. Our host families usually live in the greater Shanghai or Beijing area or in other areas of eastern China. Beijing or Shanghai itself are huge cities that go beyond our ideas of cities; millions of people already live in individual suburbs alone, and new ones are constantly being added.
