Your host family can basically live anywhere in the UK; without a desire for a region, accommodation in England is normal.

School

The British school system is generally recognised as good and is a model for many countries in the Commonwealth. In your host school, you will have compulsory subjects, elective courses and elective courses, including such interesting subjects as "Photography", "Art and Design" or "Hairdressing". As a 16 or 17-year-old, you will usually go to the upper secondary school, the "6th Form" in Great Britain.
